# The Blizzard Challenge 2020

## Evaluating corpus-based speech synthesis on common databases

In order to better understand and compare research techniques in building corpus-based speech synthesisers on the same data, the annual Blizzard Challenges 2005-2019 were held. We are now pleased to call for participation in the sixteenth challenge: Blizzard Challenge 2020. The challenge is to take the released speech data, build synthetic voices, and synthesise a prescribed set of test sentences. The output from each synthesiser is then evaluated through extensive listening tests. The following is an outline description of the challenge – for full details and the rules of participation, please see the web pages.

- **Hub task 2020-MH1: Mandarin Chinese** - About 9.5 hours of speech data from a male native speaker of Mandarin. The task is to build a voice from this data.
- **Spoke task 2020-SS1: Shanghainese** - About 3 hours of speech data from a female native speaker of Shanghainese. The task is to build a voice from this data.

Teams may submit synthetic speech for either or both tasks within their entry.

**Blizzard Workshop:** The systems will be presented by the participants at the Blizzard Challenge 2020 workshop, which we will be held in Shanghai, China; the provisional date is immediately after Interspeech 2020.
